Palm Sunday is about Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Maundy Thursday during Holy Week marks the events of the Last Supper, his betrayal and arrest. Good Friday marks Jesus' execution by crucifixion. And on Easter Sunday, we celebrate that the tomb, Jesus' grave, was empty, because he arose! Hallelujah! FPCMJ does not have a Maundy Thursday or Good Friday service this year, but we honor those events with prayer, reflection and the stripping of important symbolic items from our sanctuary at the end of the service.
